2026 marks the 31st Anniversary of the Cape Coral Police Department's "Do The Right Thing" program and the 28th Anniversary of the program providing scholarships for our youths.

2026 Scholarship Breakdown:

- Two scholarships: \$2,000.00 each
- Three scholarships: \$1,000.00 each

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Currently enrolled in the 12th grade in a Cape Coral school or be a resident of Cape Coral
2. Maintained a grade point average of 2.5 or better
3. Include a resume showing:
 - Involvement in the community
 - Leadership roles you've undertaken
 - Extra-curricular activities and awards
 - Work history
4. Include two letters of recommendation from someone who knows you well but is not a relative.
5. Included a 300-word typed essay describing:
"How being a positive role model has affected those around me."
6. While it is not a requirement, if you were a past **Cape Coral Police Department's Do The Right Thing** winner, please include a copy of your certificate or letter.

The scholarship will be for any course of study.

The application must be received at the Cape Coral Police Department by **Thursday, April 30, 2026.**

Winners will be acknowledged on our social media sites by Thursday, May 21st, 2026. The winners will be decided by a scholarship committee and required to attend award presentation. The scholarship check will be made payable to the college or university of choice upon acceptance and must be used for 2026 admission.
